Beware of: Liquids like cleaning products, paints, acids, solvents - ESPECIALLY if chemicals are in an unlabeled container! Vapors and fumes that come from welding or exposure to solvents. Gases like acetylene, propane, carbon monoxide and helium. Flammable materials like gasoline, solvents, and explosive chemicals.
