Forming regular comparatives and superlatives. Forming comparatives and superlatives is easy. The form depends on the number of syllables in the original adjective. One syllable adjectives. Add -er for the comparative and -est for the superlative. If the adjective has a consonant + single vowel + consonant spelling, the final consonant must be doubled before adding the ending.

How to form comparative and superlative adjectives. We usually add -er and -est to one-syllable words to make comparatives and superlatives: If an adjective ends in -e, we add -r or -st: If an adjective ends in a vowel and a consonant, we double the consonant:

To make the comparative form of adjectives (like 'bigger' or 'more expensive') and the superlative form (like 'biggest' or 'most expensive'), first we need to know how many syllables are in the adjective. Adjectives with one syllable Usually if an adjective has only one syllable, we add 'er' to make the comparative form. We add 'est' to make the superlative form.

Superlative and Comparative Adjectives

When we want to compare two or more nouns using adjectives, we use the comparative and superlative forms of the adjective to show the comparison between the nouns. E.g. Honey is sweet, sugar is sweeter but victory is the sweetest.
